Also in the year 2010, the company Roeltgen will again participate in numerous trade fairs. In January the Nortec trade fair takes place in Hamburg. This trade fair for production technology is taking place for the 12th time. From the 27th to 30th January you can find us in Hall A1 at Stand 204. In February we will be exhibiting at the Metav in Duesseldorf. The Metav is one of the largest trade fairs for metalwork and metal processing in Germany. Visit us from the 23rd to 27th February in Hall 16 at Stand C64. After that follows the first trade fair for the pharmaceuticals industry. The Technopharm takes place in Nuremberg from the 27th to 29th April. Here we are presenting our coding tools (Hall 5, Stand 462) and the tablet press series FlexiTab[®]. At the second-largest aviation exhibition in Europe we present our dot marking machines and stamp tools. From the 08th to 10th June we are exhibiting at the ILA in Berlin. Last but not least, the Motek takes place from the 13th to 16th September in Stuttgart. The trade fair year ends with participation at the most important trade fair for assembly technology in Europe.
